- SCYC hosts a Food Drive every year to assist local families in need.
- Special events and field trips expose children to our county and build commitment to community.
- SCYC sites offer Family Fridays each month. More than 300 community adults and parents have participated in family oriented, educational, and recreational discussions and activities.
- Sixty-nine percent of parents indicate that their child's grades have improved, while 72% believe they are more interested in school. Parents report that the children feel better about themselves and their behavior at home has improved as a result of the program.
